The CONTEST 58, A Yacht For The Discriminating Seaman

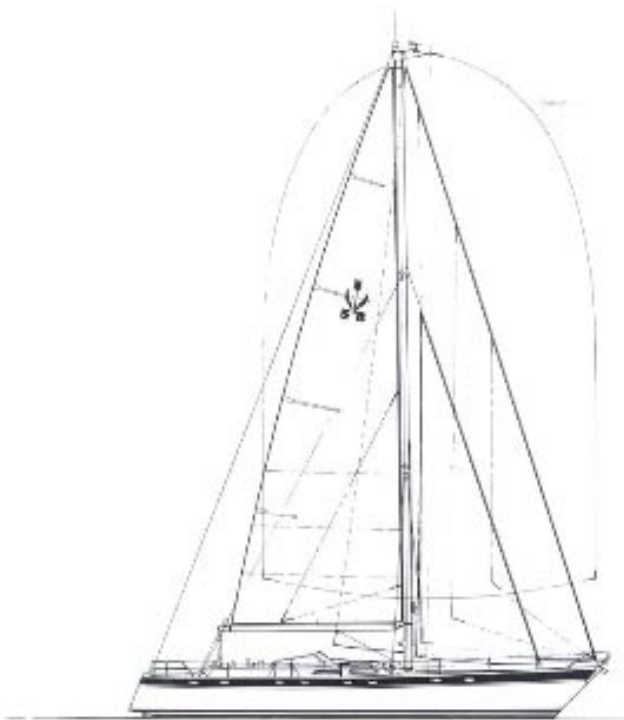
The CONTEST 58 performance cruising yacht has been designed and built for the blue water sailor. Complete safety, responsive handling characteristics and superb performance in all conditions have been the main design priorities. The CONTEST 58 with her sleek lines, reduced draft, and exceptional stability makes full-out sailing a truly satisfying experience.

Like all CONTESTS, the CONTEST 58 is built of reinforced fiberglass according to the demanding specifications of Lloyd's Register Of Shipping.

An advanced gelcoat and resin process is used, ensuring years of maintenance free cruising and longlasting exterior beauty. Characteristic of all CONTEST yachts, a truly seamanlike choice of the highest quality materials and finishes is used throughout. This is evidenced in the magnificent main saloon with spacious navigation station, chart table and complete instrument display, enhanced by ample space for charts and books. On deck the finest hardware and a spacious center cockpit makes the helmsman feel at home from the first tack. The deck lay-out is designed to allow all sail handling to be managed from the cockpit. Finally, for auxiliary power a reliable Volvo Penta diesel engine provides a cruising speed of more than nine knots and combined with the standard bowthruster allows you to manoeuvre safely in any port in the world.

With this important addition to the CONTEST fleet, designers Doug Peterson and Dick Zaal have again succeeded in giving the discerning yachtsman what he wants most: a yacht that is an exhilarating experience to sail in any sea, under any conditions.
